The appointment of the collective and selective exhibition in the tower of St. Martin in Buje is renewed. The exhibition represents a special opportunity to exhibit in a charming historic Istrian town that is visited by many foreign tourists. In recent years, the tower has become a venue for international exhibitions and cultural events. The exhibition is organized by the People's Open University of Buje in cooperation with the City of Buje, the Tourist Board of the City of Buje and Stati Generali delle Donne.

Application deadline: August 10, 2024

Ways of participation:

Interested female artists from all countries have the right to participate with a maximum of one work. The completed application form and photo of the work must be sent by **August 10, 2024** to the e-mail address: womensartbuje@gmail.com

The submitted works will be selected by an expert jury. The jury will award the first prize for the best work in the form of a personal exhibition in 2025 in the Tower of St. Martin in Buje

Works without a completely and correctly completed application form will not be included in the competition. The maximum size of the work is 200 cm x 200 cm.

Notification about the selection for the exhibition will be sent no later than August 15, 2024 to the email addresses of the applicants.

Participation in the project requires a registration fee of EUR 35.00, for students' EUR 25.00 which is paid after the selection of the works. The registration fee must be paid within 7 days of receiving the notification, otherwise the works will not be included in the catalogue and in the exhibition.

Authors who have passed the selection and paid the registration fee have to submit their work for the exhibition to the address **POU - UPA Trg J.B. Tita 6, 52460 Buje, Croatia** (in person or by post) or to another destination agreed via e-mail no later than **August 30, 2024.**

The artists must also send a photograph of the work (high resolution, in colour) to be used for the creation of the catalogue in three languages which will be included in the International Standard Book Program in Croatia and Italy (ISBN).

The organizer is unable to bear the costs of delivery and return of the works.

The works must be equipped for the exhibition and the sculptures must be of portable size. After payment of the registration fee, the works will be included in the virtual gallery on the Internet pages

of the People's Open University of Buje, where it will be a permanent virtual exhibition. Along with the reproductions of the work, the author's information and biography will be highlighted.

Materials from the exhibition and the opening (films and photos, catalogue, invitation and poster) will be included on the website of the People's Open University of Buje.

The exhibition will be open from 6 September until 11 October 2024.

Authors are asked to carefully study the propositions of the competition and to adhere to the specified deadlines for application and submission of works.
